

Native Ferns

for Auckland



Makaka Adiantum aethiopicum

- forms a large soft drift
- prefers partial shade



Rosy maidenhair fern Adiantum hispidulum

- low spreading habit
- tolerates sun



Hen and chicken fern Asplenium bulbiferum

- bulbils that grow on fronds can be potted up
- prefers partial shade



Crown fern Blechnum discolor

- eventually forms a short trunk
- prefers partial shade

These Star Performers are plants of proven excellence in suitable conditions in Auckland. Several native ferns make great garden subjects or container plants. Ferns with reddish new fronds take most sunlight, those with dark green foliage need most shade.







Swamp kiokio Blechnum minus

- keep soil constantly moist
- prefers full sun or dappled light



Rasp fern Blechnum parrisiae syn. Doodia australis

- was known as *Doodia media*
- tolerates full sun but best in partial shade

Recipe for success:



Prickly rasp fern Blechnum neohollandicum syn. Doodia aspera

- spreading groundcover
- tolerates full sun or partial shade



Alpine water fern Blechnum penna-marina

- forms a low tufted groundcover with rose-pink new fronds.
- tolerates sun
- Ensure you have free draining soil when selecting your site
- Dig in compost before planting
- · Soil should be consistently moist but not waterlogged
- Apply organic mulch after planting to retain moisture and keep roots cool
- Apply occasional deep watering in dry periods
