These Star Performers are plants of proven excellence in suitable conditions in Auckland. Generally all these native ground cover recommendations are compact, evergreen, low maintenance plants that suppress weeds.

- height 0.6m
- spring flowering

- height 0.5-1m
- spring flowering



Pinatoro Pimelea prostrata

- height 0.3m
- various cultivars available



Ground lawyer *Rubus barkeri*

- height 0.3m
- vigorous growth

Recipe for success:

- Most of these native ground covers prefer full sun
- For most ground covers, select a site with free draining soil
- Recommended planting time is autumn
- Plant the top of the root ball at the same level as the soil
- After planting, apply organic mulch
- · Little ongoing maintenance is required
