Coprosma 'Beatson's Gold'

- suited for formal hedge
- height 0.7-1.5m

Corokia x virgata

- free draining soil
- height 0.7-1.5m

Hebe diosmifolia

- spring flowering
- height 0.7-1.5m

Leptospermum 'Wiri Sandra'

- winter flowering
- height 1.5-2m

These Star Performers are plants of proven excellence in suitable conditions in Auckland. These hedges are reliable and remain compact when clipped once or twice a year.





Melicytus obovatus

- box hedge alternative
- height 0.7-1.5m



Muehlenbeckia astonii

- clip to any shape
- height 0.7-1.5m shade



***Pittosporum tenuifolium*
(dwarf types)**

- clip lightly
- height <0.7m



***Podocarpus totara*
'Matapouri Blue'**

- dense hedge
- height 2-6m

Recipe for success:

- Select a full sun site for planting
- Most plants prefer free draining soil
- Work compost into soil at time of planting
- Recommended planting time is autumn
- Fertilise annually in autumn or spring
- Clip the base slightly wider than the top
- Trim after flowering. For foliage hedges, trim in late winter or early spring
