- sprawling plants
- rich fertile soil



Lettuce

- loose leaf variety e.g. cos
- short harvest time



Silver beet 'Bright Lights'

- long productive harvest
- suitable in containers



Tomato

- cherry and large varieties
- often needs support

Recipe for success:

- Plant in a sunny, sheltered site of your garden
- Work compost into the soil at time of planting
- Apply a general fertiliser to soil and rake it in
- Plant from late October. Successive plantings ensure a prolonged harvest.
- Protect plants from slugs
