- clips well
- topiary or hedging

- distinct form
- prune for size
- provides shelter

Recipe for success:

- · Select a full sun site for planting
- · Most plants prefer free draining soil
- Recommended planting is in autumn
- Plant the top of the root ball at the same level as the soil
- Little ongoing maintenance is required
