Aeonium 'Zwartkop'

- succulent, yellow flowers
- foliage darker in full sun

Aloe plicatilis

- full sun
- succulent with interesting form

Hen and chicken fern

Asplenium bulbiferum

- lush fern
- prefers partial shade

Astelia chathamica

- remove old leaves as they age

These Star Performers are plants of proven excellence in suitable conditions in Auckland. A range of perennial plants that perform reliably in containers without regular repotting.





Begonia 'Nonstop'

- prefers partial shade
- dies down in winter



Vireya Rhododendron 'Golden Charm'

- prefers partial shade
- flowers best when slightly root bound



Streptocarpus hybrids

- prefers cool partial shade
- protect from slugs or snails



Bromeliad Vriesea hieroglyphica

- prefers partial shade
- water from the top

Recipe for success:

- Use sturdy containers with adequate drainage holes
- Use commercial potting mixes for reliable results
- Apply a slow release fertiliser as per the directions and/or liquid fertiliser applications
- Repot when signs of decline appear
- Water regularly when soil has dried out
